Camera Naturalist Photo Club 2023-2024 JUDGES INSTRUCTIONS

1. Images must be Nature only

- a) **No** hand-of-man or man-made objects are permitted no paths, roads, bridges, wires, fences etc.
- b) No people or sign of people are permitted- no footprints, mowed grass, swept beaches, cut tree stumps etc.
- c) Cultivated flowers are permitted.
- d) Zoo animals are permitted in Zoology as long as no man-made objects are visible.
- e) No <u>Obvious</u> post-processing manipulation. Adding an element to an image that was not in the original is not allowed.
- f) If there are images that do not adhere to these rules, it is the judges call to disqualify. <u>If you are unsure, please ask</u>! If an infraction is missed, the club president or other officer will make the call.

2. <u>Competitions categories</u>

- a) Ornithology Birds dominant
- b) Botany Plants, Flowers, Fungi dominant
- c) **Zoology** Animals, insects, butterflies, reptiles dominant
- d) <u>General Nature</u> –Includes anything that does not fit into the categories listed above
- e) <u>Special Assigned Categories</u> For Special Assignment category contests, additional information specific to each type of contest will be provided.
- 3. <u>Three Member Classes:</u> B-Beginner, A–Advanced and Salon. The B group can submit a total of 3 images; A Class and Salon are limited to 2 images.
- 4. Images are to be to be judged on <u>technical merit as well as compositional and artistic</u> <u>impact.</u> Storytelling is an added bonus but <u>does not</u> take priority over technical merit, compositional and artistic impact.

5. Scoring

Images are reviewed in two passe

- a) first pass: images are scored from 5 to 7.
 - 5's or 6's are out
 - 7's move onto the second pass.
- b) second pass: images are scored from 7 to 9:
 - o 7's are out
 - 8's = Honorable Mention
 - \circ 9's = Equal Merit
 - There are no limits to the number of 8s or 9s that can be awarded.
- 6. <u>Commentary Please provide comments for the images on the first pass</u>, especially for the B class.
- 7. <u>Communicating</u> with the maker of the image is not allowed. Any questions must be directed to the president or club officers.

- 8. <u>In Person Competition Meetings</u> 7:30-9:30. Competitions usually begin with a short meeting to discuss club business. Should time become a concern the projectionist or club officer will let you know.
- 9. <u>Zoom</u> judges will be asked to sign in at 7:15 to make sure everything is running correctly.
